# Notice of Race 2013 C15 North American Championship August 23, 24, 25 in Beaux Arts Village, WA



Organizing Authority: Beaux Arts Racing Fleet and the Coronado15 class association

- 1. Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, US Sailing prescriptions and the Coronado 15 Association by-laws.
  - 1.1. The following prescriptions of US Sailing will not apply: rule 60, rule 63.2 and rule 63.4.
  - 1.2. The following prescriptions of US Sailing will apply: Appendix T, rule T1, rule T2 and rule T5.
  - 1.3. Racing rule 26 will be changed as follows: The timing sequence of rule 26 will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 3. **Eligibility:** Members in good standing of the Coronado 15 association. The membership application is included in the entry form if needed.
- 4. Entries: Entries can be submitted by sending a completed and signed entry form (see below) or in person at the event. Mail-in entries will only be accepted until August 17, thereafter, entries shall be made in person no later than 9:00am the day of the event. Deadline for early entry fee is August 10<sup>th</sup>.

#### 5. Fees:

5.1. Early entry (On or before Sat. August 10<sup>th</sup>) \$75
5.2. Standard entry \$100
5.3. Juniors under 18 \$25

Note that the membership dues for the C15 national association are not included in the race entry fee. The fees are only \$25 per year and include the subscription to the Mainsheet magazine

#### 6. Qualifying series and Final Series

- 6.1. On Friday, the contestants will compete for the Syd Corp trophy. Based on the results from the qualifying series on Friday and the number of entrants, the fleet may be split between A and B fleets for the championship at the 1/2 point or a natural point within three boats of the 1/2 point. This shall be determined by the RACE COMMITTEE." (C15 NAC Policy 4a)
- 6.2. Saturday and Sunday, the competitors will race for the 2013 North American Championship (NAC).

#### 7. Schedule of Races:

- 7.1. On Friday, the race committee will try to run 5 races. The warning signal will be at 12:55. The race committee will attempt to end racing at 6 PM.
- 7.2. On Saturday and Sunday, the contestants will compete for the North American championship in a series of no less than 7 races. Saturday and Sunday, the warning signal will be at 9:55.
- 7.3. Racing on Saturday is expected to end at 17:00 with a lunch break in the middle of the day.
- 7.4. Sunday, no race will be started after 13:00.

#### 8. Measurements:

- 8.1. C15s racing in the North American Championship and/or qualifying series must meet the weight and measurement policies as specified in the By-laws on <a href="https://www.coronado15.org">www.coronado15.org</a>.
- 8.2. Sail measurement is required only for sails that were not previously measured and signed.
- 8.3. Boat weight may be checked ahead of race day by arrangement with Aaron Sharp Asharp@htnb.com.
- 8.4. Crews must have a combined minimum weight of at least 300lbs. Competitors will be asked to carry additional weight if necessary.

#### 9. Sailing Instructions:

9.1. Sailing instructions will be available at Coronado15.org web site on August 17

#### 10. Venue:

The racing will take place on Lake Washington, WA near Mercer Island. See map below

#### 11. Courses:

- 11.1. Courses will be primarily windward/leeward using inflatable marks and possibly a reaching mark. The course will be off the Beaux Arts Village shoreline on Friday.
- 11.2. If conditions allow, the race course will be north of Mercer Island on Saturday and Sunday.

#### 12. Scoring

When fewer than seven (7) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

#### 13. Launching and Parking

- 13.1. The Western Academy of Beaux Arts (WABA) shoreline is a private property that provides members and guests access to a launch ramp and a grassy area for rigging and temporary storage of boat trailers. Racers can access the facility only when accompanied by a WABA member. At least one WABA Member will be available each day after 09:00 to assist non-members in accessing the launch ramp. Contact Aaron Sharp <a href="mailto:Asharp@htnb.com">Asharp@htnb.com</a> if necessary outside of the racing days.
- 13.2. There is a small parking area near the shoreline that can only be used for temporary loading/unloading. Trailers will be allowed to remain on a designated area of the green belt. Cars will be parked on nearby private driveways that will be assigned ahead of time, following registration.
- 13.3. Out of town racers may wish to bring their boat on Thursday afternoon to check out the facility and race area. Special arrangement may be made for a WABA member to be present after 14:00 on that day.

#### 14. Trophies:

- 14.1. The Coronado 15 Syd Corp Cup trophy will be awarded to the 1st place qualifier from the Friday races.
- 14.2. For the North American championship, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3rd place trophies will be awarded in both the A & B fleets.

#### 15. Hospitality:

- 15.1. Saturday and Sunday, a light breakfast and lunch will be provided for the racers.
- 15.2. The Beaux Arts Racing Fleet will be hosting a potluck dinner on Saturday following racing.
- 15.3. The Coronado 15 class association annual dinner and meeting will be held on Friday on the WABA shoreline after racing, weather permitting.
