Notice of Race

Organizing authority : The Sailing Foundation, Redmond, WA

RULES: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

The following prescriptions of US Sailing will not apply: rule 60, rule 63.2 and rule 63.4.

The following prescriptions of US Sailing will apply: Appendix T, rule T1 Penalties at the time of Incident and rule T5

Racing rule 26 starting sequence will be stated in the sailing instructions.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY: The event is open to C15, Thistle, Lasers, CFJ, Etchell, J24 and any one design fleet under 25feet with five boats or more including youth fleets Boats not making a class will race PHRF. One-Design classes will be accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Chair based on the number of entries and the classes that are established

This regatta is open to members of US Sailing Association affiliated yacht clubs or Sailing Organizations and to foreign sailors who are members of their respective National Governing Authorities. C15 association membership is required in order to race a C15.

Eligible boats may enter by filling the entry form and paying the entry fees.

Five (5) PAID entries are required to establish a class. Classes may be started together but scored separately. Boats that do not establish a class may be placed in PHRF or Portsmouth.

Competitors' meetings will be held Friday and Saturday at 09:00 at Beaux Arts beach.

Sailing Instructions

SAILING instructions will be available on line at Coronado15.org no later than 20:00 on Thursday 6/30 or at Beaux Arts Beach at Checkin

Venue

This event will be held in Lake Washington just north of Mercer Island. See below image

Scoring

When five (5) races or less have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. Friday racing will be scored separately from Invitational Saturday and Sunday

C15 Scoring: On Friday, based on the results from the Syd Corp qualifying series, "The split between the "A" Fleet and the "B" Fleet shall be made at the 1/2 point or a natural point within three boats of the 1/2 point. This shall be determined by the RACE COMMITTEE." (C15 NAC Policy 4a). Competitors who are unable to race the qualifying series will be placed in the "A" fleet.

Measurement

Participants in the C15 championships must comply with the class association measurement rules, including boat weight and crew weight. Weighing will take place at Beaux Art shoreline on Thursday pm or Friday am.

Launching

Launching is available for dinghies at a small ramp at Beaux Arts beach SE 27th St, Beaux Arts, WA. There are many public ramps close by. The closest is the public ramp on Mercer Island under I-90.

Parking and storage

The C15 fleet will be hosted at Beaux Arts Beach with overnight trailer parking for traveling competitors. All other fleets are welcome for all dinner and awards presentations but will need to moor boats at other marinas. Can we be more specific? Have we secured ability for boats to launch at other locations for instance?

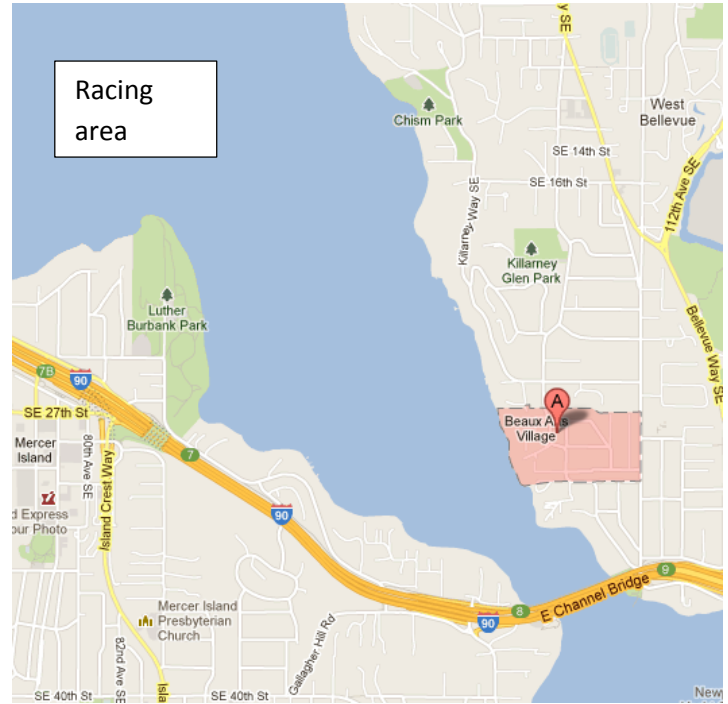
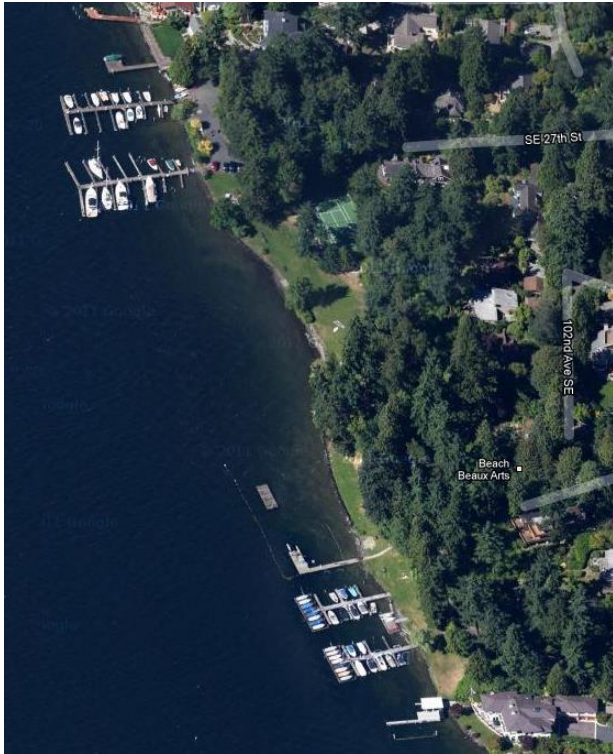
C15 Annual Association meeting
