North American Championship Regatta 2019
July 18-20, 2019 Lake Washington, WA

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The location for this event is at Western Academy of Beaux Arts' (WABA) Beach in Beaux Arts Village on Lake Washington, WA., located just east of Seattle.
- 1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the racing rules as defined in the United States Sailing Association's the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020.
- 1.3 The Coronado 15 Association Class Bylaws apply.
- 1.4 The racing rules will appear in full in the sailing instructions for races run on Thursday July 18, 2019 for the Syd Corp series, and Friday and Saturday July 19, 20, 2019 for the Coronado 15 North American Championships. Sailing Instructions will be provided on Thursday on the morning of the Syd Corp series.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY (Must enter both the NAC)

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Coronado 15 sloops that comply with Coronado 15 Association Bylaws AND at least one member of the team is a current registered member of the Coronado 15 Association. Proof of membership must be provided upon registration.
- 2.2 The Junior NAC Series is open only to helmsman who are 18 years of age or younger. Crew can be of any age.
- 2.3 The Cabrillo division and Championship division for the Coronado 15 North American Championship Series will be based on:
 - 2.3.1 The Results of the Syd Corp Series
 - 2.3.2 Boats not competing in the Syd Corp Series can petition to sail in the Championship division, and a competitor may opt to move to the Championship division from the Cabrillo division following the end of the Syd Corp.

- 2.4 **2019 Coronado 15 North American Championships Entry:**

3.0 FEES - North American Championship:

- 3.1.1 Standard Fee is \$150. This fee covers the racing for the Syd Corp on Thursday, and both days of the Coronado 15 North American Championship on Friday and Saturday.
- 3.1.2 Friday and Saturday dinners are included and two 2019 NAC hats.
- 3.1.3 You are invited to Wednesday BARF race at 6:30 pm with dinner is included RSVP for head count is requested.
- 3.1.4 A late fee of \$25 will apply to entries received after June 1.
- 3.1.5 Junior Entry in the Junior NACs is waived.
- 3.1.6 Note that the \$25 Coronado 15 National Association membership fee is not included in the regatta entry fee and must be paid separately. Class membership dues can be paid by mail, PayPal, or at registration for the event. <http://www.coronado15.org/c15-assoc-membership-form/>
- 3.1.7 Extra hats can be purchased for \$15 each
- 3.1.8 Guest meals for Friday and Saturday cost \$10 each.

4.0 SCHEDULE

2:30 pm First racing sequence begins for *Syd Corp Series*. Five races are planned. Race 2, 3, 4, and 5 starting sequence will begin 5 minutes after the last boat finishes.
6 or 7:00 pm *Junior NACs* race 1 sequence begins (if wind permits).
Junior NAC race 2 start sequence begins 5 minutes after the last boat finishes.
6-8 pm Gathering and social at the fire pit adjacent to the north parking lot of the WABA Beach in Beaux Arts.

- 11:55 am Warning Signal for Second day of *Championship Division* and the Cabrillo Division races. (No races after 3:30pm)

- 7:00pm National Association meeting and elections

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions (SI) and the Notice of Race (NOR) will be available at the check in area (boat ramp parking lot) at the WABA Beach in Beaux Arts on Thursday. A copy of both the SI's and NOR's will be emailed to registered competitors who provide their email address by the end of the registration period.

6.0 VENUE

- 6.1 Races will be run on Lake Washington through the Beaux Arts Racing Fleet (BARF).
- 6.2 Marks and courses will be described in the SI's as well as reviewed during the first skipper's meeting.

7.0 SCORING (*NACs will include races run on Thursday, Friday and Saturday*)

- 7.1 For the **2019 Coronado 15 North American Championships**:
- 7.1.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A of the RRS will apply.
- 7.1.2 One race shall constitute a series.
- 7.1.3 If fewer than six (6) races are completed for the NAC's, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores (no throw-outs). If six (6) or more races are completed, the worst excludable score will be excluded.

8.0 MEASUREMENTS

- 8.1 C-15's racing in the North American Championships and/or qualifying series must meet the weight and measurement policies as specified in the most recent adopted By-laws of the C-15 Class Association. The Bylaws are available on www.coronado15.org. Entrants are solely responsible for ensuring their compliance with the class rules.
- 8.2 Sail Measurement is required only for sails that have not previously been measured and signed by a qualified class member.

- 8.3 All boats must be weighted and measured prior to entering the water. The Beaux Arts venue will provide a scale for weighing located in the boat launch parking lot and participants shall be prepared to weigh their boats upon arrival before stepping their masts.
- 8.4 Crews must have a combined weight minimum of at least 300 lbs. minus any excess weight of the boat above 385 lbs. Competitors will be required to carry additional weight as loose ballast if necessary.
- 8.5 Boats are expected to comply with all relevant measurement criteria as specified in the Coronado 15 Association Bylaws.

9.0 BERTHING

- 9.1 Overnight boat trailer parking will be available on the grass area adjacent to the boat launch parking lot. No fees will apply for this overnight storage.

10.0 PRIZES

- 10.1 **Syd Corp Series:**
 - 10.1.1 Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers.
 - 10.1.2 Syd Corp Series winners' names will be added to the Syd Corp perpetual trophy.
- 10.2 **North American Championships Series** (Championship and Cabrillo Classes)
 - 10.2.1 Results will include the races run through the Beaux Arts Racing Fleet.
 - 10.2.2 Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th place finishers in each division.
 - 10.2.3 Each division winner will get their name added to the NAC's perpetual trophy.

11.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See **RRS 4, DECISION TO RACE**. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damaged or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12.0 CHARTERS
